- Monitor gauges related to times, pressures, and temperatures
- Monitor product flow with respect to smooth and unrestricted movement of product through the entire system utilising SCADA – managing inputs and outputs
- Ensure all quality standards, work instructions and safety requirements are met
- Log pertinent information into log sheets at appropriate intervals
- When necessary, sample product in accordance with established methods and procedures
- Perform basic operator troubleshooting and repair of equipment
- Maintain a clean work area including proper care and storage of tools/equipment
